



The World Health Organization (WHO) has declared that COVID-19 is no longer a global public health emergency. WHO issued a declaration calling COVID-19 an international crisis on January 30, 2020. Since that time, COVID-19 has taken the lives of at least 7 million people worldwide, including over 1 million in the U.S.
